PEOPLE

PLACES

places for art classes, exhibits, bands, concerts, or plays
landmarks, buildings, and places of historical or cultural significance
green spaces where things happen like trails, parks, and fairgrounds

ENTITIES

nonprofits like museums, galleries, theaters, cultural centers, and art schools
creative businesses, senior centers, 4H, churches, historic societies, and libraries
groups promoting cultural traditions, languages, ethnic identities, and community history
art commissions and informal groups, knitting circles, clubs, and more...

EVENTS

events or activities that that celebrate community, art, culture, or history
fairs and festivals, first Fridays, summer concert series, farmers markets, and more...

public art - murals, sculptures, monuments and interactive installations in public spaces
